Construction Safety

Six Hour Online HD-Video Course



Course Description

This six hour course is a review of the safety codes required for residential construction. Students will be able to understand and describe the basic components of a construction safety program. They will recognize the hazards inherent at a construction jobsite, and describe ways to prevent those hazards. Finally you will learn the responsibilities of both the employer and the employee in observing established safety practices.

This course is available online in full HD-video format. Students log in, watch each video, then take a 5-10 question quiz at the end of each lesson. Students must get a passing score of at least 70% in order to move from lesson to lesson and to receive credit for the course.
